MOTION # 1

MOTION #2

Supervisor Palow moved to establish the second Wednesday of each month at **7:00** p.m. as the time and date for **REGULAR TOWN BOARD MEETINGS** and the fourth Wednesday of each month at **7:00** p.m. if necessary to conduct town business. These meetings will be held at the Berne Community and Senior Services Building located at 1360 Helderberg Trail, Berne NY. The motion was seconded by Councilmember laCour and carried by the following vote: Supervisor Palow, Councilmembers Doolin and laCour all voting aye.

MOTION #3

Councilmember Doolin moved that the SUPERVISOR be and he hereby is authorized to pay all utility bills and postage without prior audit, debt payments, and approved signed contractual obligations. The motion was seconded by Councilmember laCour and carried by the following vote: Supervisor Palow, Councilmembers Doolin and laCour all voting aye.

MOTION #4

Councilmember Doolin made the motion seconded by Supervisor Palow that the **HIGHWAY SUPERINTENDENT** be and he hereby is authorized to purchase gas and diesel fuel through state contract. The motion carried by the following vote: Supervisor Palow, Councilmembers Doolin and laCour all voting aye.

MOTION #7

Councilmember laCour made the motion, seconded by Councilmember Doolin that the Supervisor be, and he hereby is authorized to enter into an agreement with the **HELDERBERG AMBULANCE** for the year 2025 at a cost of \$101,132 Motion carried with the following roll call vote Supervisor Palow, Councilmembers Doolin and laCour all voting aye.

MOTION #8

Councilmember laCour moved to authorize the HIGHWAY SUPERINTENDENT to spend up to \$5,000 for purchase of tools, tires, parts and equipment from New York State contract and/or the Albany County Purchasing Department; other County, State or Federal contracts without prior approval by the Town Board. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Doolin and carried by the following vote: Supervisor Palow, Councilmembers Doolin and laCour all voting aye.

MOTION #9

Supervisor Palow made a motion seconded by Councilmember Doolin to enter into an agreement with the Berne Public Library for the year 2025 for the purpose of operating and supporting in conjunction with the Library Board of Trustees and Upper Hudson Library Systems, motion carried with the following vote: Supervisor Palow, Councilmembers Doolin and laCour all voting aye.
